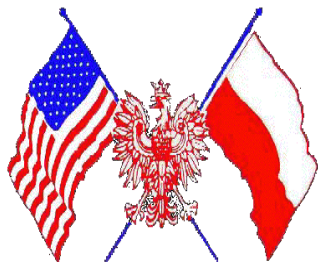
Membership Meeting Guest Speakers

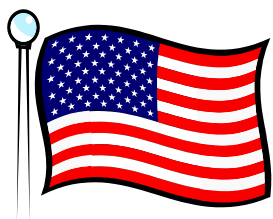
