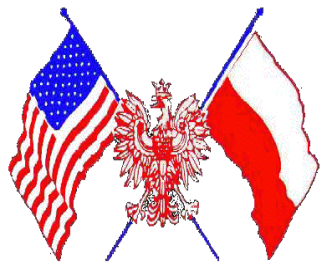

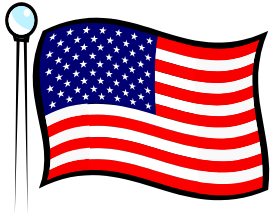
### **Runnemed 4th of July Parade**

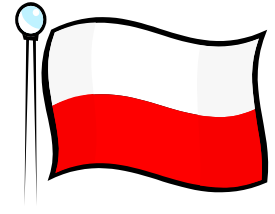
### **Did You Know That?**

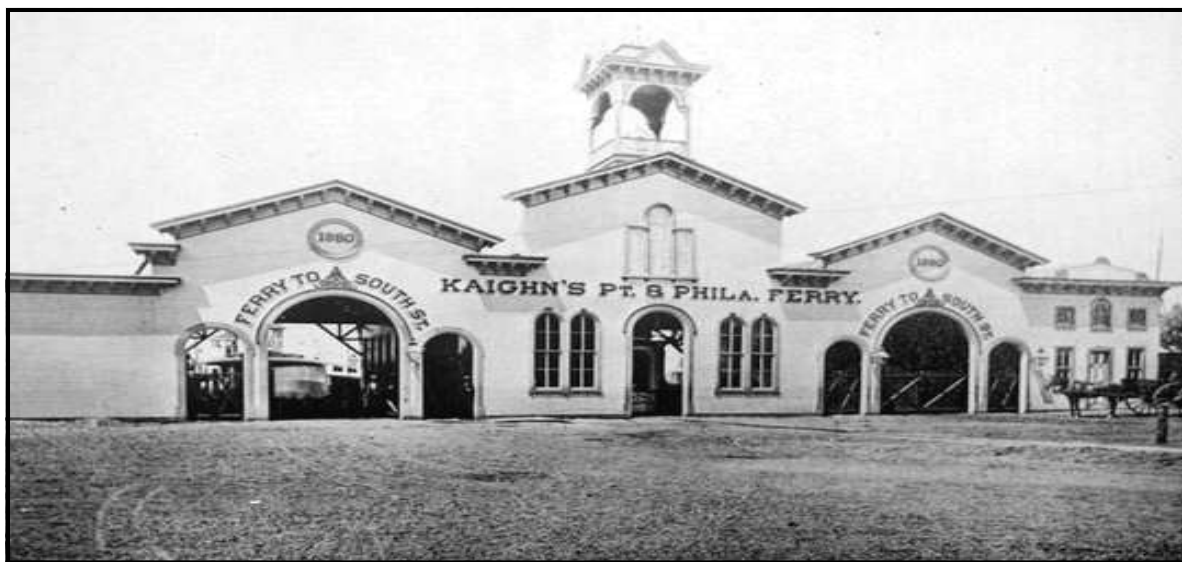
