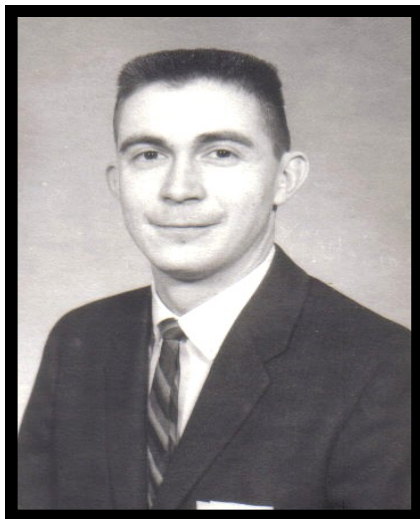

Postcard picture of West Jersey Hospital, Mt Ephraim and Atlantic Avenues. Circa 1966

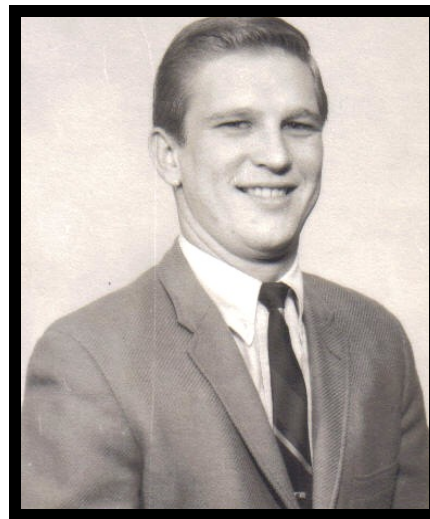
