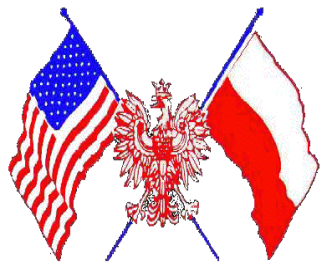

The picture attached is of the 1953 Whitman Park Lions of the Whitman Park Little League. The names of some of the players are written above the picture. Here are the names.

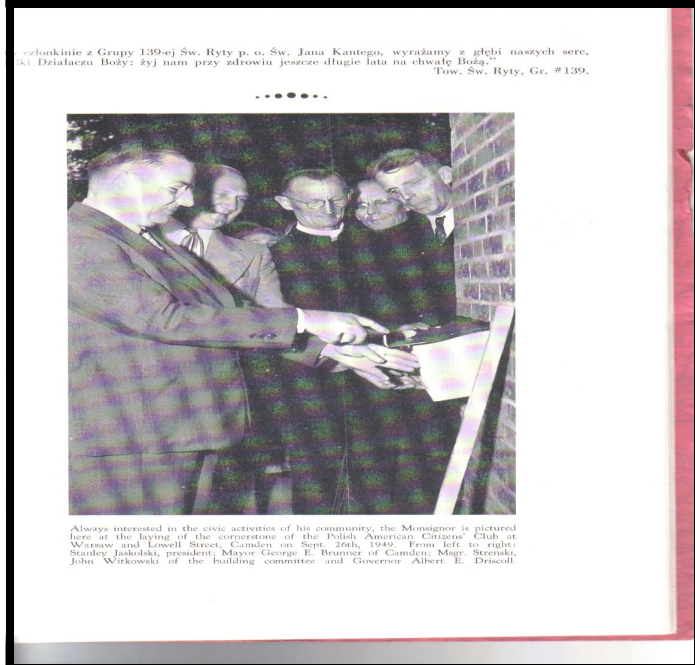
